Not content to rest on this reputation, Silverado introduced its first rare Limited Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon bottlings in 1990, beginning with the release of the fabulous 1986 vintage. Limited Reserve is held to a very high standard. It is produced only in outstanding years when superior wine expresses distinctive vineyard character and the highest winemaking skill.

Marking the tenth vintage of wine grown, produced, and bottled on the estate, Silverado introduces its 1990 Limited Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, only the third to be made. A selection of the best wines from this superb vintage, it was carefully assembled in the cellar and given extra bottle age before release. Limited Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon is made entirely from the twenty four year old Disney Vineyard, which helped establish Stags Leap District’s reputation for great reds. This remarkable wine bursts with ripe, generous aromas and is loaded with rich currant, spice, and toasty oak flavors. Supplies are limited.
